Lake County reports....

After days of hot, dry weather and increased water demand, groundwater levels across Lake County are low. For households served by wells, (as Oak Terrace is) it is extremely important everyone conserve water by limiting its use. Increased water demand, combined with lack of replenishment from rainfall, can cause fluctuations in groundwater levels in the County's shallow aquifers, which are not immediately replenished by rainfall, and will only recover over time. Many communities have instituted restrictions on watering lawns and washing cars, to ensure there is an adequate supply of water for drinking, bathing, cooking and fire protection.

For well owners experiencing low water pressure issues or sputtering (air mixing with water) in any of your fixtures (faucets, toilets, etc.), you should stop using the water and contact your local well contractor to avoid running the well dry and burning out the pump. Pin # Consolidation

Here's some bare bones information for consolidating pins if you haven't already: Map Services of Lake County: 847-377-2373. online at: http://www.lakecountyil.gov/Mapping/Pages/Default.aspx. The Board is now, by law, required to collect dues from each individual lot, unless they are consolidated. The pros and cons of consolidating have been discussed for a goodly while at Board meetings. The bottom line is that if you intend to consolidate and do not do so fairly soon you will receive a dues bill for each lot at the end of the year.
